

Gwent **BOOST** Project



The Gwent BOOST project is a five-year National Lottery funded project, working in partnership with service providers throughout Blaenau Gwent, Caerphilly, Monmouthshire, Newport and Torfaen.

BOOST delivers new initiatives to people at risk of homelessness, currently experiencing homelessness or with lived experience of homelessness, ensuring they are empowered with the tools and skills they need to move on with their lives, leaving homelessness behind for good.

The project builds on what is already working in Gwent.

Cyfannol Women's Aid is working alongside St Giles Cymru to deliver a Peer Advisor Programme for women who have experienced Violence Against Women, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence.

The Programme:

- Provides opportunities for women to gain experience and skills.
- Provides opportunities for women to achieve qualifications.
- Addresses the shortage of skilled staff in the care and support sector and other front-line roles that play a key role in tackling homelessness.
- Champions the value of introducing staff and volunteers with lived experiences into work.

Participants are supported to:

- Complete a 12-part "Learning to Advise" course.
- Carry out a volunteer work placement in the care and support sector, with the option to complete an NVQ Level 3 qualification in Advice and Guidance.
- Progress into employment.

- Darparu cyfleoedd i fenywod ennill profiad a sgiliau.
- Darparu cyfleoedd i fenywod ennill cymwysterau.
- Ymdrin â'r diffyg mewn staff medrus yn y sector gofal a rolau rheng flaen eraill sy'n chwarae rôl allweddol mewn mynd i'r afael â digartrefedd.
- Hyrwyddo gwerth cyflwyno staff a gwirfoddolwyr gyda phrofiad byw i weithluedd.

Bydd cyfranogwyr yn derbyn cymorth i:

- Gwblhau cwrs "Dysgu Cynghori" 12 rhan.
- Ymgymryd â lleoliad gwaith yn y sector cymorth, gyda'r opsiwn i gwblhau cymhwyster NVQ Lefel 3 mewn Cyngor ac Arweiniad.
- Symud ymlaen i gyflogaeth.
